A Budget for Peace not War

Government spending on Britain's nuclear weapons system and on overseas war is escalating year on year.

- Next year we will be spending £2 billion a year on Trident - almost twice as much as 5 years ago
- And we spend at least another £2 billion a year conducting the disastrous and unwinnable wars in Iraq and Afghanistan
- Most Scots think the money should be spent instead on tackling poverty and climate change
- Scotland's share of that money would be £340m a year - enough to support at least 10,000 new public service jobs.

How would YOU spend the money?

- Would you use it to launch a major housebuilding programme to provide affordable housing for homeless and inadequately housed families?
- Would you increase spending on health and education and create thousands of new public sector jobs?
- Would you use it for energy conservation and efficiency and to create a ground breaking renewable energy industry in Scotland?
- Would you use it to increase overseas aid and debt relief to tackle poverty across the world?
